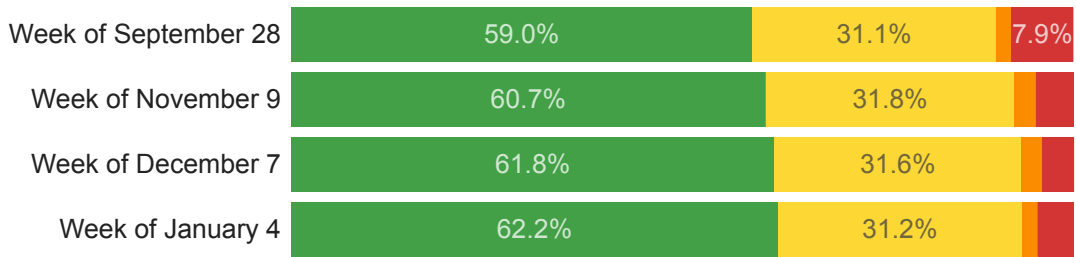


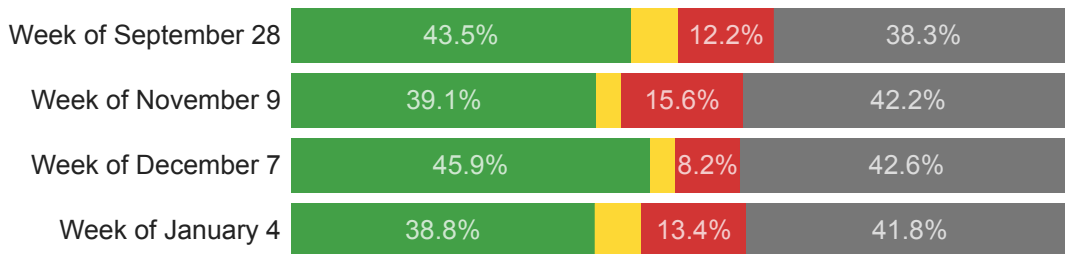

***[If not employed]* Are you currently receiving unemployment benefits?**

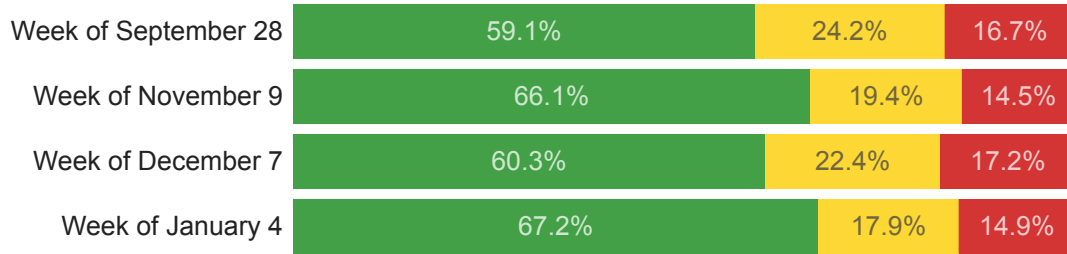


- Yes

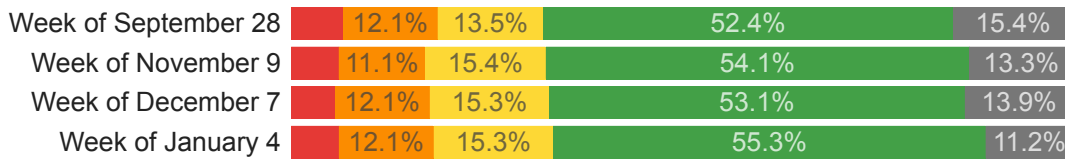

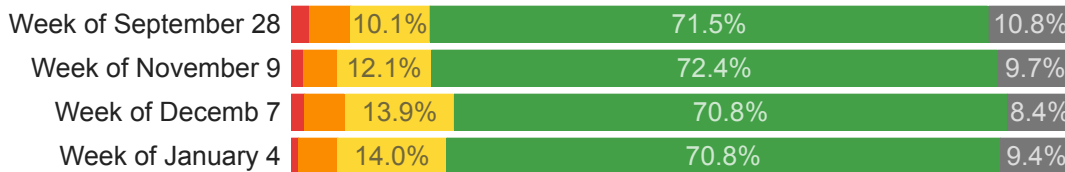

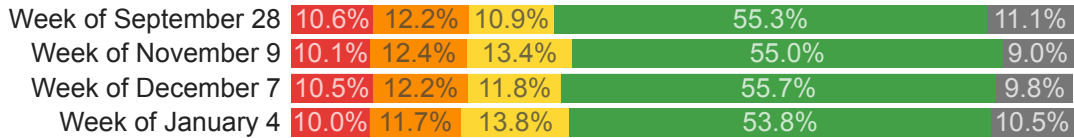
