- Grantee will submit to the ADAF a written report regarding the Project and the use of the grant proceeds by June 26, 2009. If the Project is not completed by that date, a report must be filed by June 26, 2009, noting a project completion date, and a final report must be sent upon completion of the Project.
- Grantee will provide to the ADAF with the written report, copies of educational materials (e.g. brochures and Web copy) developed by the Project, using ADAF grant proceeds. Educational materials cannot be returned. Grantee hereby grants a perpetual, nonexclusive license to ADAF to display, use, publicize and disseminate any such materials for purposes of promotion of dental health, education and research.
- Grantee will submit photographs (digital preferred), and/or other recordings, in audiovisual, sound, moving images or otherwise, if available, related to the Project for use in various ADA and/or ADAF publications, along with signed ADA FOUNDATION PUBLICITY RELEASE(S). (Please send via email to FamularoR@ada.org, or on a CD. Such materials cannot be returned.)
- Grantee will forward to the ADAF any news articles, web postings or other publications promoting and mentioning the programs (see contact information below).
- Grantee agrees that grant proceeds will not be used for lobbying purposes, and will not be used to support or oppose any policy decision or any political candidate at any level of government.
