REGISTRATION INFORMATION

SAVE TIME

Fees increase after September 12. Advance registrants receive their Annual Session badge and tickets prior to the meeting—no waiting in registration lines!

SAVE MONEY

Avoid the fees increase! Registration and CE course ticket fees increase after September 12.

GUARANTEE YOUR SEAT*

CE course and event tickets are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

* *Tickets for fee courses, Education in the Round and workshops guarantee your seat for the duration of the course. Tickets for no-fee courses hold your seat until the published start time of the course.*

AFTER SEPTEMBER 12, ALL FEES WILL INCREASE AND REGISTRATION MATERIALS WILL NOT BE MAILED.

ADA SHUTTLE PASS

REGISTRATION AND CE COURSE TICKET FEES INCREASE SEPT. 12

Register by Sept. 12 to avoid fees increase. All sales are final for registrations and tickets purchased after Sept. 12.

CONFIRMATIONS

An acknowledgement of registration/housing will be sent via contact information provided, immediately after processing.

A confirmation of registration/housing will be sent via contact information provided, within 72 hours of processing.

Please allow 5-7 days if requesting acknowledgement or confirmation by U.S. Mail.

BADGE AND REGISTRATION MATERIALS

If you register by the Friday, September 12, 2008 deadline, your badge and registration materials will be mailed to the address provided (materials cannot be mailed to P.O. boxes). Each primary registrant will receive an envelope containing his/her badge and tickets, and the badges and tickets for any friends and family they have registered.

If you register after Friday, September 12, 2008, your registration will be processed at the increased registration fee. You will receive a confirmation, but you must pick up your badge and other materials at the on-site registration area (please bring your confirmation and photo I.D.).

Registrants from outside the U.S. must pick up their badges and tickets at the International Registration counter located in the on-site registration area. Please present your registration confirmation and photo I.D.

CANCELLATIONS, REFUNDS AND CHANGES

DENTAL PROFESSIONAL REGISTRATION

Each registrant must complete a separate Registration and Housing Form.

This process will ensure that you receive your registration materials and tickets directly and that Primary Registrants in professional registration categories obtain verification of continuing education course attendance. Exceptions to these procedures are those registrants whose appropriate category is Friends and Family (U.S. Friends and Family, International Friends and Family, AADA Member, U.S. Children under 18, International Children under 18).

All dentists, including non-practicing dentists, must register in the appropriate dentist category and will be charged the correct corresponding fees. HOW TO COMPLETE STEP 1

PRIMARY REGISTRANT REGISTRATION

EACH REGISTRANT MUST COMPLETE A SEPARATE PRIMARY REGISTRATION AND HOUSING FORM. SEE PAGE 115 FOR COMPLETE INFORMATION.

Your registration materials will be mailed to the address listed on the form. Registration materials cannot be mailed to a P.O. Box. Registrations received and tickets purchased after Sept. 12 will not be mailed and must be picked up at on-site registration.

REGISTRATION FAQS

Q: Can I register even if my dentist is not attending?

A: Yes. You must register as a dental professional in the appropriate category.

Q: How can I correct the information on my badge?

A: Prior to September 13, 2008, you may correct your badge information online at www.ada.org/goto/session by accessing your registration record using your registration ID number. You may also go to the badge correction area at the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center.

Q: My spouse is also a dentist but is not currently in practice. Does my spouse have to register in a dentist category?

A: Yes, each registrant is expected to register in the appropriate category. Spouses who are dentists are considered dentists and must register as such. Dentists who register incorrectly will be charged the appropriate registration fee.

Q: Can I order CE course and special event tickets for my staff on my registration form?

A: Yes. However, staff members must register and order their own CE course tickets separately.

Q: Can I register for two tickets for the same time of day?

A: No, only one ticket per time slot is permitted. If more than one course per time slot is listed, the first entry will be chosen.

To reserve a room, complete Step 6 and include the names of all occupants in each room. All reservations require a deposit of \$150 and will not be processed without the proper deposit amount. Fill in the total fees on the “Step 6 Subtotal” line.

It is to your advantage to register promptly, as hotel rooms are reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. Refer to the listing of hotels on page 103 for amenities and rates.

HOTEL FAQs

Q: Can I make a hotel reservation if I am not registered?

A: No, hotel accommodations are reserved for registrants of the Annual Session only. However, registrants may reserve up to three rooms for friends and family that are accompanying them to San Antonio.

Q: Can I select the Annual Session headquarters hotel for my stay?

A: No, the headquarters hotel is necessary for individuals involved in the business meetings of the ADA that are held during the Annual Session. Therefore, it is not available for general reservations.

Q: What is the amount of the deposit?

A: In San Antonio, hotels require a deposit of \$150 per room (\$300 for a 1-bedroom suite, \$450 for a 2-bedroom suite).

Q: Is shuttle service provided to ADA hotels?

A: Shuttle service is provided to all ADA hotels not within walking distance of the Convention Center. Shuttle service is not provided to and from the Westin La Cantera and Hyatt Hill Country Resorts in the Hill Country area.
