

ADA FOUNDATION 2011 STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT

The ADA Foundation (ADAF) is pleased to grant to the undersigned student (Student) a scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 for the 2011 year. In consideration of the receipt of Scholarship funds, the Student agrees as follows:

1. Student represents and warrants that (a) Student is currently enrolled as a full-time student at the educational institution listed at the bottom of this Agreement ("Educational Institution"); (b) Student is taking a minimum of 12 credit hours; and (c) Student has maintained the minimum grade-point average (3.50) required for application to the ADAF Scholarship Program and will work diligently to continue to maintain same.
2. Student understands that although the Scholarship check will be made payable to Student, it will be sent directly to the Educational Institution's financial aid office; and Student agrees to work with the Educational Institution's financial aid office and follow its policies regarding endorsement and disbursement of scholarship monies.
3. Student agrees that Scholarship funds will be used exclusively to defray educational costs such as tuition, fees, books, and supplies. To the extent Scholarship funds are used for living expenses or otherwise, Student understands that the amount so used will constitute taxable income to Student, for which Student will be responsible for payment of all taxes thereon.
4. Student agrees to forfeit and return to ADAF the full amount of the scholarship award within thirty (30) days' of change in status from full-time to part-time student, or withdrawal or dismissal from the Educational Institution.
5. Student agrees to furnish to ADAF such records, reports, transcripts, and certificates as ADAF may reasonably request from time to time. Student further agrees that ADAF may contact the Educational Institution from time to time to obtain such information as ADAF may deem appropriate in connection with the Scholarship.
6. Student agrees that ADAF may contact himself/herself for purposes of promoting its scholarship programs, and agrees, if contacted, to voluntarily provide, and let ADAF use, photographs, quotations, or other information to help ADAF in its public relations and fundraising efforts.
