

**New Standard 5-1**

**Advanced General Dentistry Education Program in Oral Medicine**

Applicants **must** have one of the following qualifications to be eligible to enter the advanced general dentistry education program in oral medicine:

- a. Graduates from a predoctoral dental education program accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation;
- b. Graduates from a predoctoral dental education program in Canada accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation of Canada; and
- c. Graduates from an international dental school with equivalent educational background and standing as determined by the institution and program.

**Revised Standard 4-5**

**Advanced General Dentistry Education Program in Orofacial Pain**

Applicants **must** have one of the following qualifications to be eligible to enter the advanced general dentistry education program in orofacial pain:

- a. Graduates from a predoctoral dental education program accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation;
- b. Graduates from a predoctoral dental education program in Canada accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation of Canada; and
- c. Graduates from an international dental school with equivalent educational background and standing as determined by the institution and program.

**New Standard 4-2**

**Advanced General Dentistry Education Program in Dental Anesthesiology**

Applicants **must** have one of the following qualifications to be eligible to enter the advanced general dentistry education program in dental anesthesiology:

- a. Graduates from a predoctoral dental education program accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation;
- b. Graduates from a predoctoral dental education program in Canada accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation of Canada; and
- c. Graduates from an international dental school with equivalent educational background and standing as determined by the institution and program.

**New Standard 4-2**

**Advanced Education Programs in General Practice Residency**

Applicants **must** have one of the following qualifications to be eligible to enter the advanced education program in general practice residency:

- a. Graduates from a predoctoral dental education program accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation;
- b. Graduates from a predoctoral dental education program in Canada accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation of Canada; and
- c. Graduates from an international dental school with equivalent educational background and standing as determined by the institution and program.
