**TABLE 1. SYMPTOMS OF CHRONIC FATIGUE SYNDROME**

<b>Common Symptoms</b>	<b>Symptoms present in 20-50% of CFS patients</b>		
fatigue that is not improved by rest or sleep	abdominal pain	dry eyes	panic attacks
impairment in short-term memory or concentration	alcohol intolerance	earaches	shortness of breath
sore throat	anxiety	insomnia	Sjögren's syndrome
tender lymph nodes	bloating	irregular heartbeat	skin sensations
muscle pain	chest pain	irritability	tingling sensations
multi-joint pain without swelling or redness	chronic cough	morning stiffness	TMJ disorders
headaches of a new type, pattern or severity 24 hours	depression	myofascial pain	weakness
unrefreshing sleep	diarrhea	nausea	weight loss
post-exertional malaise lasting more than 24 hours	dizziness	night sweats	xerostomia
