<p>CSA Voting Rules for Contested Elections</p> <p>Resolved, that if the election of the Chair or Vice Chair at the June 26, 2020 meeting results in a contested election, the CSA will adhere to the following rules:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When two candidates have been nominated and no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast, one or more runoffs shall be held, as necessary, until one candidate receives a majority of the votes cast. • When three or more candidates have been nominated, and no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast, the candidate having the lowest vote shall be removed from the ballot for a successive vote. One or more runoff ballots shall be held, as necessary, until one candidate receives a majority of the votes cast. On each runoff ballot, the name of the candidate who received the lowest vote on the previous ballot will be eliminated. 	Adopted
