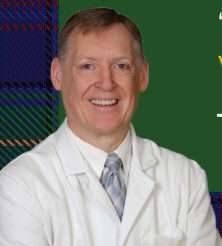

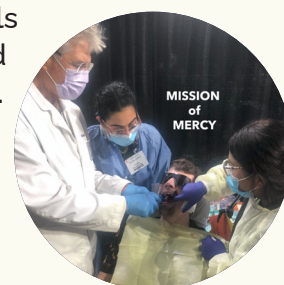


JIM'S STORY

Born in California, Jim grew up in a large family that encouraged excellence in academics and athletics, emphasizing treating others with respect and kindness. The oldest of 6 children, he attended the University of Pittsburgh, where he studied Biology and History, and lettered in two D-1 varsity sports: baseball and volleyball. After a sports injury, he focused on gaining early entrance to Northwestern University Dental School. Following graduation from dental school, he was commissioned as a Lieutenant in the US Naval Dental Corps and practiced general dentistry for the next five years. His tours of duty included San Diego, CA; Fallon, NV; Rota, Spain; two aircraft carriers; and the U.S. Naval Academy. While in the Navy, Jim completed a four-year oral & maxillofacial surgery residency at UNC-Chapel Hill. He retired from the Navy after 21 years of active and reserve duty.



Dr. Boyle entered private practice in central Pennsylvania in 1996, eventually opening a practice in York, PA. He credits his ability to successfully treat patients and make a difference within organized dentistry to his family and office "teammates" who support his busy schedule. Jim enjoys mentoring high school and college students considering dentistry as a career. He volunteers with Mission of Mercy, as a state-board anesthesia inspector, as an active staff member at a Level 1 hospital-based 8-person GPR residency program, was a PIAA basketball official, and thoroughly enjoyed coaching boys and girls youth basketball. He renewed his focus on maintaining a healthy work-life balance and embarked on a personal mission of training for triathlons, reigniting his love for cycling. Often, patients will see Dr. Boyle ride his bike to and from work. Jim and his lovely wife, Jane, have been married 27 years and are parents to five children (the youngest at Penn State University), are grandparents to four young grandchildren, and are "dog parents" to one fluffy guardian dog, Seamus.
