# **Advanced Dental Admissions Test (ADAT)**

## Examinee Information Report

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## **Introduction**

The reports published by the Advanced Dental Admission Test (ADAT) Program are intended to provide information on ADAT examinees to stakeholders and communities of interest, including dental educators and practitioners, state and federal agencies, and other interested parties.

The information provided in this report reflects data collected during the 2020 through 2024 ADAT administration years. Examinees' self-reported demographic information was collected during the application process. If examinees did not respond to a question on the application, they were considered non-responders to that question. The "total" number indicated in each table represents the total number of examinees.

This report contains information about examinees' self-reported gender, ethnicity, whether they spoke English at home, dental school attended, dental school year of graduation, dental school year (if current student), highest degree achieved, dental school grade point average (GPA), and the reported specialty area of interest.
