☐ Your education and training information.
☐ Your Individual NPI Number.

☐ Hospital affiliation information.
☐ A copy of your anesthesia license.
☐ A digital copy of your DEA (Drug Enforcement Administration) license.
☐ A digital copy of your CDS (Controlled Dangerous Substances) license.
☐ Medicare numbers.
☐ Medicaid numbers.
☐ BLS (Basic Life Support) certification information.
☐ ACLS (Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support) certification information.
Depending on the state in which you practice, additional information may be required. You will also be asked to sign one or more Authorization, Attestation, and Release documents after attestation.
