To streamline your credentialing paperwork process and spend more time with patients, **any U.S. licensed dentist can use this service for no cost, regardless of their current ADA membership status.**

Here's what you'll need to begin completing the simple form at [ADA.org/godigital](https://www.ada.org/godigital).

These items are necessary to complete your credentialing application:

- A copy of your state license
- A copy of your professional insurance face sheet
- Practice information
- NPI Number

You may also need the following:*

- Hospital affiliation information
- A copy of your anesthesia license
- A copy of your DEA (Drug Enforcement Administration) license
- A copy of your CDS (Controlled Dangerous Substances) license
- Medicare number
- Medicaid number
- BLS (Basic Life Support) certification information
- ACLS (Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support) certification information

*Depending on the state in which you practice, additional documents may be required.
