About This Study

To better understand the economic and operational conditions in dental practices and public health clinics over time, and to measure the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and other emerging issues in dentistry, the ADA Health Policy Institute launched a tracking poll in January 2022. For the initial wave over the week of January 17, 2022, we invited nearly 80,000 dentists from across the U.S. to join a panel in which they will complete a survey once a month; over 3,000 have opted to participate.

The survey for the week of December 11, 2023 was sent to 3,292 panel members; 971 responded, for an adjusted response rate (excluding undeliverable email addresses) of 29.6%. The number of dentists in private practice who responded in each wave, along with the number of respondents in each reporting category in the current wave, can be found at the end of this report.

Below are the results from the latest wave for dentists working in private dental practices. The report includes breakouts by ownership status, DSO affiliation, practice size, geographic location, sex, age group, and race/ethnicity. Unless noted otherwise, charts reflect the results from the latest wave of data collection. **Please note that we only include graphics representing at least 30 responses.** Because of this, we were not able to include results for respondents in the following categories: DSO, under age 35, large group (10+ dentists) and Black. The number of respondents by demographics can be found at the end of this report.

This report was published in December 2023 by the American Dental Association's Health Policy Institute.






