

## National Dental Expenditures, 2022

**0.3%** NATIONAL DENTAL EXPENDITURES DECREASED by 6.3% from \$176 billion in 2021 to \$165 billion in 2022 (constant 2022 dollars).






## IN CONSTANT DOLLARS, 2022 DENTAL SPENDING **IS SIMILAR TO 2019** SPENDING. From 2019 to

2022, the share of dental spending from government programs increased from 13% to 17%.
