1. Approved the agenda and consent calendar, as presented.
2. Approved a recommendation to the ADA Board of Trustees to consider the following areas of expertise when nominating and selecting CSA members for the 2024-2028 term: Pediatric Dentistry; Prosthodontics; Oral Medicine, and Dentist (preference for standards or digital technology expertise).
3. Approved a process for handling external requests for use of CSA-developed ACE Panel survey questions.
4. Approved a document entitled, “Decision Tool for CSA Products” for use in the development of scientific materials.
5. Approved a proposed SmileCon 2023 CE course entitled, “ADA 2023 Clinical Practice Guideline on the Use of Surgical Treatments for Caries Lesions.”
6. Approved that the CE Subcommittee will review the list of published CSA clinical practice guidelines and provide prioritization recommendations no later than the July 2023 meeting.
7. Approved prioritization of the Sedation and Anesthesia guideline review and revision of the 2012 ADA/FDA radiographic guidelines for completion by the Council in 2023.
